

Substantial Amendment to the City of Brockton FY2008 Annual Plan for CDBG and HOME funds.

The City of Brockton's FY2008 Annual Plan approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is to be amended as described herein and only to the extent described herein. Funds will be reassigned from "Rescue of Foreclosed Homes" and credited to Clearance, Demolition and Removal of Buildings and Improvements. Clearance, Demolition and Removal of Buildings and Improvements will be a new project consistent with the Citizen Participation Plan and the allowed uses under 24CFR Part 570. The National Objective is to provide additional affordable housing. The following shall add a project to the Annual Plan.

20. Clearance, Demolition and Removal of buildings and improvements

Priority: sites for affordable housing

Objective: Decent Housing

Funding: \$83,961

Funds will be used to demolish buildings and improvements; remove rub

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21. Clearance, Demolition and Removal of buildings and improvements

Priority: sites for affordable housing

Objective: Decent Housing

Funding: \$90,000

Funds will be used to demolish buildings and improvements; remove rubble and debris after demolition; remove environmental contaminants or treat them to make them harmless; and to move structures to other sites. Funds will only be used clear a blighted area; clear to eliminate specific blighted conditions; and clear as part of an activity designed to alleviate serious threats to public health and safety where there are no other funds available. Funds will be used to ready sites for affordable housing.

This program will be administered by Building a Better Brockton, Inc in conjunction with the City of Brockton.
